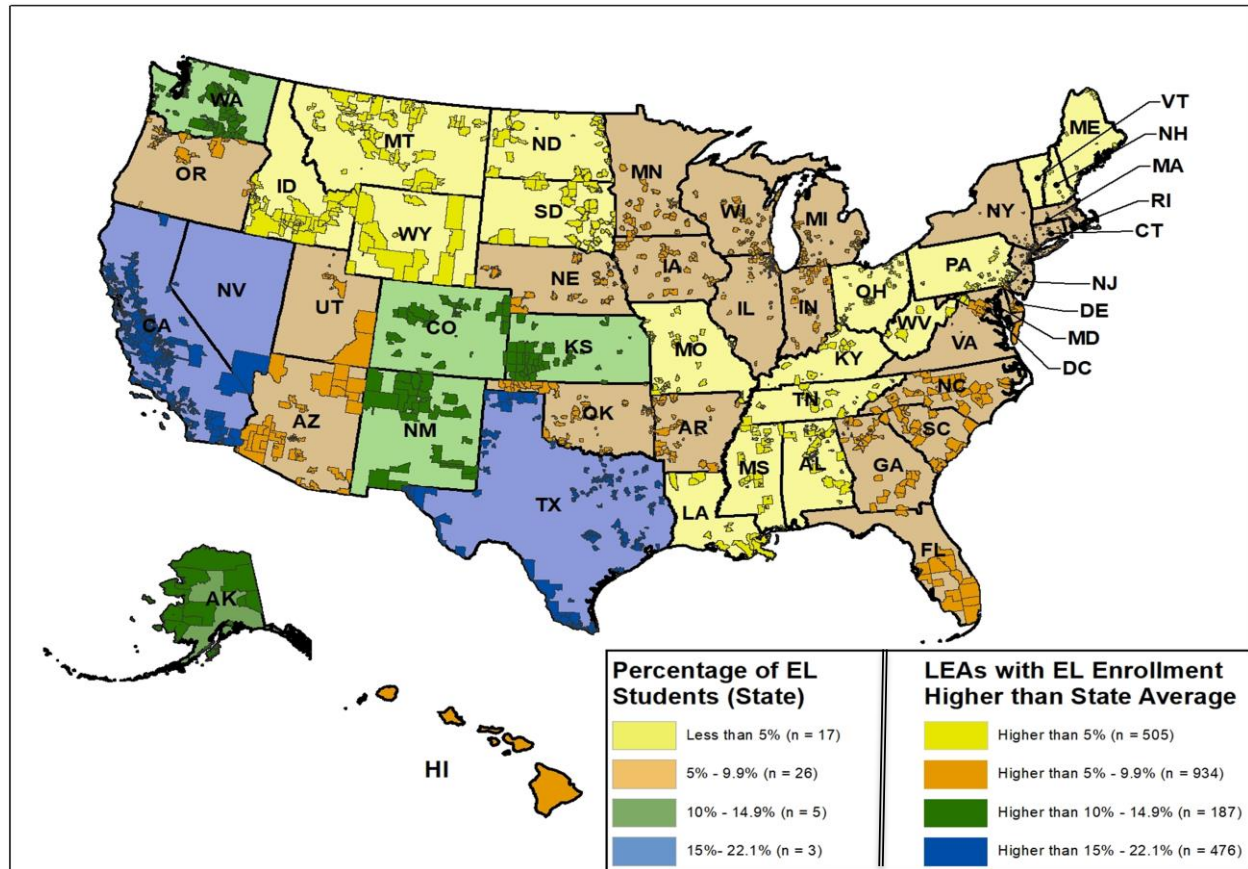




English Learner (EL) Populations by Local Educational Agency

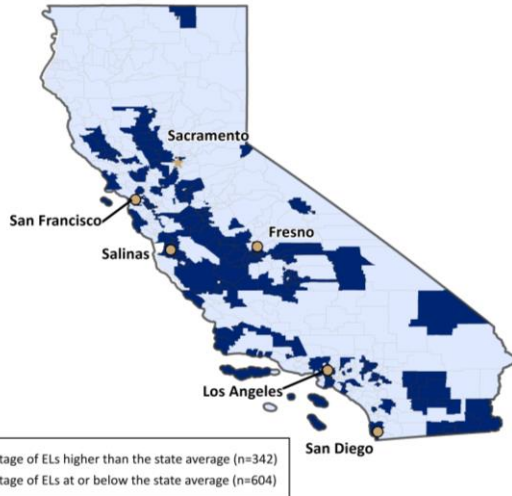
Percentages of Students Who Are ELs, By State (Including DC), and by Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) With EL Enrollment Higher Than State Average, SY 2014-2015



Fact

- In SY 2014-15, ELs represented between 15% to 22.1% of all enrolled students in CA, TX and NV public schools, and were spread across **476** LEAs.
- Analysis of Common Core of Data (CCD) showed that during SY 2014-15, **CA, TX, and FL** were the top three states with the highest percentage of ELs and accounted for approximately **60%** of the total EL population in U.S. public schools.
- ELs accounted for approximately **10%** of the total number of students enrolled in U.S. public schools in SY 2014-15.

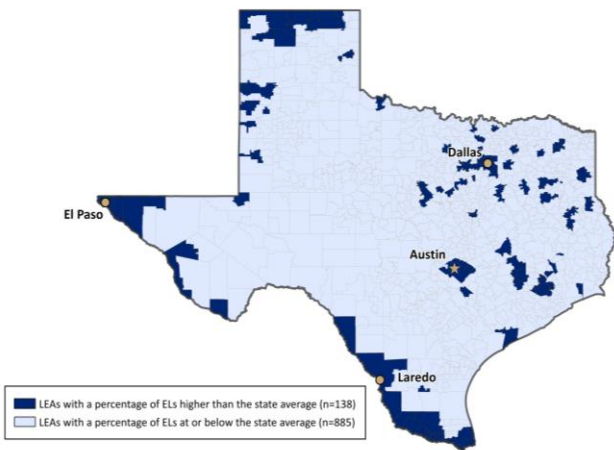
Fact

- In SY 2014-15, ELs accounted for **22.1%** of the student population in California.
- **342** LEAs in California had a higher percentage of ELs than the state average.



Fact





- In SY 2014-15, Nevada's public schools reported approximately **16.4%** ELs.
- Two (2) LEAs had a higher percentage of ELs than the state average: Clark County School and Washoe County School Districts.



Fact

- In SY 2014-25, ELs represented nearly **15.7%** of the student population in Texas.
- **138** LEAs had a higher percentage of ELs than the state average.
